

Million Dollar Calculator!!??

Dear NAME,

How could a Calculator be worth a Million Dollars?

Well in the 1940's during the Manhattan Project (atomic bomb) performing the arithmetic calculations manually was VERY time consuming and difficult. IF Person A would have had a TI-30Xa Scientific Calculator and no one else had one, then Person A would have been like a magician and the calculator would have been worth a million dollars.

The TI-30Xa Calculator has saved me immense amounts of time compared to the old days of not having one. Yes, I used to use Log and Trig Tables and a Slide Rule or SlipStick. UGH!

In fact it would have been worth a million dollars when I was 16 years old if I had the only one that existed at that time. Here's a bit of history I lived through.

The very first scientific calculator came out in 1972 thanks to Hewlett Packard, the instrument company. It was the HP-35 and cost about \$2,500 in 2022 Dollars (\$395 in 1972) and was MUCH harder to learn and use than the TI-30Xa..

BUT, the HP-35 was an immense improvement over the old manual tools of the day and thousands of students who could afford it bought one.

I was teaching advanced math at Rose Hulman Institute of Technology in Indiana at that time and the HP-35 was like a "miracle product". Slide Rules were now obsolete!

HP sold 100,000 calculators their first year, only expecting to sell 10,000, and then lowered the price to \$195. But soon, Texas Instruments came out with a much better one for under \$100.

NOW, today (2023), you bought the TI-30Xa for about \$1.50 in 1972 Dollars. AND, it is MUCH BETTER.

If you are a "newbie," it may take you a month or so to Master the Keys I teach you. If you already have used calculators, it might only take you a few days.

BUT, you do want to Master the Keys I am teaching you so you can then Learn Practical Math in less than One semester. Algebra, Geometry, and Trigonometry used to take three years to learn.

So, Onward!
